

2012 Learning Can Be Fun FAQs:

- 1) **How much do Learning Can Be Fun classes cost?** Courses are \$129 unless otherwise noted.
- 2) **Are scholarships available for LCBF classes?** Some scholarships are available, based on financial need; contact Continuing Education at (540)453-2215.
- 3) **Do I need to pre-register my child(ren), or can I do that on the first day of classes?** We strongly recommend registering early – classes fill quickly, and instructors may not have enough supplies for students who sign up at the last minute.
- 4) **What do you mean by “rising grade”?** That is the grade level your child will enter this fall.
- 5) **My child is one year younger/older than the listed grades for the class, can he/she still attend?** The decision to let a child who is younger or older than the listed grade levels is contingent upon permission from both the program coordinator and the class instructor.
- 6) **If my child cannot attend his/her class, can I get a refund?** You must withdraw no later than one week before the first class to receive a refund; no refunds are issued after that time.
- 7) **Where will I drop off my child(ren) for class?** Parents and children report to Armstrong Hall for registration/check-in on the first day of classes. For classes that meet off-campus, parents and children should go directly to the class site listed in the brochure and check in with the BRCC staff member there.
- 8) **Where do I go to pick my child(ren) up at the end of the day?** Children should be picked up from their classrooms. With advance written permission, older children may leave the classroom and meet parents outside.
- 9) **What if I’m running late and won’t be able to pick up my child(ren) on time?** Parents are expected to make arrangements to pick their child(ren) up on time following each class. If an emergency keeps you from reaching BRCC on time, please call Continuing Education at (540)453-2215 to alert a staff member.
- 10) **Are snacks provided?** McKee Foods generously provides snacks on Monday for classes that meet on campus; children may bring snacks from home or buy them in the cafeteria the rest of the week. *Please note that children enrolled in day-long classes that meet/travel off-campus (Water Adventure Week, Outdoor Adventure Sports Sampler, Crime Scene Investigation, etc.) need to bring a snack, packed lunch and drink each day.*
- 11) **My child is taking one class in the morning and another in the afternoon –is lunch provided and will he/she be supervised between classes?** The program does not provide lunch, and regulations prohibit BRCC from providing official supervision during the meal break. Children are to stay in the cafeteria during the lunch hour. Please let your child(ren) know that game tables in the cafeteria are off-limits to LCBF attendees. **NEW THIS YEAR**, LCBF offers a *Storytime* class for children in rising grades K-4 that meets from noon to 1 p.m. Students are to bring a bag lunch (with drink), and will hear a different story each day, plus take part in a fun art activity. *Storytime* participants who attend morning and/or afternoon sessions will be escorted to/from the *Storytime* hour by LCBF staff.
