

G3 Income Eligibility Guidelines for 2022-2023

Students in G3 programs must file the FAFSA each year to document that they meet the income requirements for the program. For the 2021-2022 Academic Year, a student's family must earn less than 400% of the poverty level for their household size.

In the chart below, find the number of people in your household in the first column. The corresponding amount in the "400% of Poverty" column is the maximum total family income allowable to be eligible for G3. We will confirm this using the information reported to FAFSA.
