Your earned A.A.S. counts as LO1 for Mary Baldwin College. You will transfer a maximum of 39 credits automatically with the Associate Degree in Nursing. You can also transfer the General Education courses you completed during your pre-requisite work for the BRCC Nursing Program (26 credits). Total Minimum Credits to Complete the B.S.N. = 126 credits. You must take at least 36 credits from MBC. (The RN to BSN Program at MBC is 34 credits, only 1 additional course must be taken at MBC.) All transferring coursework must reflect a "C" or better, minimum of 2.5 overall GPA required. ADN and current unrestricted RN license required prior to enrolling in RN to BSN Program coursework at MBC. You may begin to take general education courses needed while waiting to take the NCLEX-RN.
