4. These courses can be taken at ODU or VCCS. If taken at VCCS, choose courses from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html> in the following categories: 6 credits in Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Literature, Interpreting the Past or Foreign Language. Remaining lower-division general education requirements are met by completion of all courses outlined in this transfer agreement guide.
