What are the admission differences between Pathway 1 and Pathway 2 Options?

Pathway 1: Targeted for healthcare professionals who have an applied associate degree (AAS) in one of the following programs and who would like to move into a management position which requires a bachelor's degree:

Allied Health Degrees

Emergency Medical Services	Occupational Therapy Assistant
 Health Information Management 	 Physical Therapy Assistant
 Medical Lab Technology 	 Radiography
 Medical Sonography 	 Respiratory Therapy

Pathway 2: Prepares the student without any health care experience or background to work in a health care management position in a hospital or medical office setting.

How are classes taught in the BPHM program?

- Synchronous on Zoom with some asynchronous options.
- Meetings are one evening per week from 7pm-10pm (EST).
- Classes are recorded in the event a student has a work conflict as we recognize many health care professionals may have evening or rotating shifts.

How long does it take to complete a BPHM degree?

• Students who transfer in the maximum 60 credit hours and take 2 classes each fall, spring and summer can complete the program in approximately 3 years.

When can a new student start the BPHM degree?

• We admit students in the Fall and Spring. Applicants use the SCPS online application on our website, and NOT the UVA Common App.

Note: Applicants for Fall admission can have transferable course work in progress during the preceding Spring and/or Summer terms. Applicants for Spring admission can have transferable course work in progress during the preceding Fall term.

What is the best way for a student to learn more about the BPHM degree?

 A student can meet in a 1:1 with the Recruitment Outreach Specialist assigned to your school.

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What is the process for a student to request a pre-admission review of their transcripts?

 Students upload copies of their unofficial transcripts which are evaluated by a preadmission advisor. The student will receive detailed feedback on how their coursework fulfills requirements for admission:
