3. CAD 225 will be used to fulfill CET 260 for this agreement only; Consult with ODU advisor.
4. MEC 111, CAD 241, MEC 112, EGR 245, MEC 211, and EGR 285 will be used to fulfill 2 of the 5 CET Electives required.
5. These courses can be taken at ODU or VCCS. If taken at VCCS, choose courses from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html> in the following categories: 6 credits in Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Literature, Interpreting the Past or Foreign Language. Remaining lower-division general education requirements are met by completion of all courses outlined in this transfer agreement guide. *These courses are beyond the completion of the AAS degree.
