

Parent or Legal Guardian Form for Self-Sufficiency Correction For Blue Ridge Community College

Students who wish to prove Virginia domicile through a parent or legal guardian must have this form completed and submitted, along with parent documentation to the Office of Student Records at Blue Ridge Community College. Documents can be submitted securely through [DropSecure](#) or dropped off in person at the Welcome Desk in the Houff Student Center. Eligibility for in-state tuition rates, as a dependent, will be reviewed in accordance with the [Code of Virginia](#).
